D. CUPS RECYCLING RECEPTACLES AND OTHER SUPPLIES

Historically, the soft drink and non-alcoholic bottled beverage contractor has provided the Zoo paper cups in varying sizes and recycling receptacles at no cost. In the middle of the previous contract the Zoo switched to compostable cups and paid the additional cost. The cups have been branded with the contractor's national brand product. The Zoo expects compostable cups to be provided at no cost. Other beverage supplies, such as table tents, ice bins, displays, umbrellas/umbrella stands and zoo-themed vending machine fronts have been provided at no cost.

Proposers shall submit specification sheets for their self-serve dispensing units with top mounted ice cube makers.

Questions and Answers

- Q1: What cup sizes does the Zoo use?
A1: 12 oz and 16oz.
- Q2: Is water hookup available to temporary/mobile carts?
A2: Yes. Carts are located near water access; however, drains are not available.
- Q3: Are ice machines required on all soda dispensers?
A3: Not currently, but it is the zoo's preference that all dispensers have top mounted ice cube makers.
- Q4: Would canned and bottled beverages be allowed to be used in the temporary/mobile food carts.
A4: Yes.

All other terms and conditions of this solicitation remain the same.
