Description of facility/application

Aloha Garbage Company (Aloha) submitted an application to renew its Metro solid waste facility license to operate a material recovery and yard debris reload facility. Current operations would not change under this proposed renewal.

Aloha accepts and processes mixed non-putrescible waste to recover recyclable materials. The facility also accepts yard debris for grinding and reloading to composting facilities.

Aloha only receives and processes waste loads that are serviced and hauled by its waste collection company. The facility has been operating under a Metro license since 2003; the term of the new license would extend through June 30, 2017.

The subject property is zoned commercial (COM) and the use is allowed in this zone.
