Application of GreenWay Recycling, LLC for a Metro solid waste license renewal to operate a mixed non-putrescible waste material recovery facility

Description of facility/application:

GreenWay Recycling, LLC has submitted an application to renew its Metro solid waste license to operate a material recovery facility. GreenWay Recycling accepts and processes mixed non-putrescible waste to recover and recycle marketable materials. The facility also accepts source-separated materials including yard debris, wood waste and asphaltic roofing shingles. The facility has been licensed by Metro since 2007 to conduct material recovery.

Current operations will remain unchanged with the exception of one proposed activity: on-site grinding of recovered and source-separated asphaltic roofing shingles. The material will be delivered to hot mix asphalt plants and processed into pavement for road construction projects. This proposed activity will require explicit authorization by both the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality and Metro.

According to the City of Portland, the subject property is zoned Heavy Industrial (IH). The use is allowed outright in this zone.
