General Items/Clarifications of Specifications

- Bidders may not request additional information or interpretation of contract/RFB documents after end of business Wednesday May 25, 2011.
- It is the Bidder's responsibility to accurately measure the fence sections. Measurements in the bid documents are estimates. The selected Contractor shall be held to the prices bid per section. Call Melanie Briggs at 503-220-5718 or Randy Whitworth 503-220-5720 to make an appointment to take measurements.
- Section 2.8, Privacy Slats, Part A, Point 2 of Attachment A, Chain Link Specification is changed to read: "Installation direction as shown on Drawings or in not indicated, install vertically for 75% privacy."
- Clarification of Note 6 on Sheet 2 of the drawings: Fencing should be 8 feet from the height of the sidewalk to the top of the barb wire.
- Contractor is responsible for the removal of materials.
- Contractor may have to remove minimal vegetation. The perimeter is clear twice a year in spring and fall.
- Contractor shall be responsible to remove and replace all "No Trespassing" signs. There should be one every fourth panel. The contractor shall purchase and install "No Trespassing" signs that match existing signs so there is one in every fourth panel.
- A attendance sheet of the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting is attached.

All other terms, conditions and requirements of the RFB remain in full force.
