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# Columbia River Crossing Project Land Use Final Order (LUFO) Public Hearing

The Metro Council will hold a public hearing on April 12, 2012 to consider amending existing Land Use Final Order for the Expo Center/Hayden Island segment of the South/North Light Rail Project on remand from LUBA and the Oregon Supreme Court. This amendment will remove the portion of the LUFO adopted on August 11, 2011 that is outside the urban growth boundary.

You can comment by testifying at the public hearing or submitting your testimony in writing to Metro. Since this is a limited decision, dealing with only the single issue directed by the Supreme Court, public comment must be directed only to that issue. All other aspects of previous LUFO decisions are final, have been confirmed by the Supreme Court, are not covered by this resolution and not subject to reconsideration.

Submittal of written testimony for the record in advance of the hearing is strongly encouraged. Written testimony submitted in advance of the hearing must either be mailed or hand delivered to Metro addressed as follows:

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Only oral testimony at the hearing and written testimony received prior to the close of the public hearing will be included in the record.

At the close of the hearing, the Metro Council will consider adoption of the amended Land Use Final Order.

Failure of a person to raise an issue orally at the hearing or in writing in advance of the close of the hearing, or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the Metro Council an opportunity to respond to the issues raised, will preclude appeal by that person to the Oregon Supreme Court based on that issue.

Appeals from this action by the Metro Council in adoption of the Land Use Final Order must be personally delivered to the State Court Administrator and the office of Metro's Council President within 14 days following the date that the Land Use Final Order is reduced to writing and bear the necessary signatures.

Written notice of adoption of the Land Use Final Order will be sent only to the parties to the appeal at the Oregon Supreme Court and to those who provide all of the following:

- In writing, a request for written notice of the decision;
- Written or oral testimony; and
- A valid mailing address.
