

1990-2012 Daily Vehicle Miles Traveled (DVMT) Data

1. Portland-Vancouver, OR-WA Urbanized Area: Is designated by the FHWA as a 'Federal-Aid Urbanized Area' (UZA 27), and includes Portland, Oregon and Vancouver, Washington. The 1995-2008 data is from the FHWA, and for 2009-2012, from the ODOT & WDOT Highway Performance Monitoring System (HPMS) program offices in Salem, OR & Olympia, WA respectively. 2. Portland, Oregon ONLY Data: The second dataset is for the Portland portion only of the above noted Portland-Vancouver Area. The data is directly from the FHWA and ODOT/ HPMS for 1990-2012. The sub-set of information for Portland only is extracted as a separate group of figures. The geographic area of Portland is uniquely defined in the HPMS program, and includes portions of Multnomah, Washington, and Clackamas Counties in OR.

*In 2012, the **Portland only** Daily Vehicle-Miles Traveled was estimated to be 28,396,897 miles, divided by a population of 1,525,000. The **Portland-Vancouver, combined DVMT** was 34,720,897 miles, divided by a population of 1,886,339. (2012 population data is an estimate based on the 2010 Population Census)*
