**Description of facility/application**

Environmentally Conscious Recycling, Inc. (ECR) has submitted an application to renew its Metro solid waste facility license to operate a material recovery facility. Current operations would not change under the proposed renewal.

ECR accepts and processes mixed non-putrescible waste to recover recyclable materials such as construction and demolition waste. The facility also accepts and processes yard debris for delivery to composting facilities, and source-separated wood waste for delivery to facilities with industrial boilers that use the recovered wood to generate energy for use in place of non-renewable fossil fuels.

ECR occupies just over 9 acres of land in Northeast Portland. The facility has been operating under a Metro license since 1986; if renewed, the term of the proposed license would extend through June 30, 2018.
