Description of facility/application

S&H Logging, Inc. (dba S&H Recycling) has submitted an application to Metro seeking a solid waste facility license to operate a new yard debris reload facility. The term of the proposed license would extend through December 31, 2018.

If Metro grants this license, the facility will be authorized to accept and grind yard debris for reloading to facilities that produce compost. The facility will also be authorized to accept and grind source-separated wood waste for delivery to facilities with industrial boilers that use the recovered wood to generate energy for use in place of non-renewable fossil fuels.

According to the city of Portland, the property at which the facility will be located is zoned Heavy Industrial (IH). The proposed use is allowed outright in this zone.
