


Tualatin River Greenway

A continuous trail along the Tualatin River in Tualatin provides residents north and south of the river with the experience of nature as they travel for recreation and jobs.



BENEFITS

- Provide easy access to the river and a series of parks including Brown's Ferry Park, Tualatin Community Park, Cook Park, Durham Park, Jurgen's Park and Tualatin River National Wildlife Refuge.
- Pedestrian bridges over the Tualatin River bring the north and south communities together with access to the trail.
- Reduce the barrier that I-5 poses for pedestrians and cyclists.
